Communication & Language

At home - if you are out and about in the Countryside, take time to look at the fields and Talk to your child about what you see.

Literacy

We will be having daily story sessions and also time to independently look at books. There will be non-fiction books about farming and also spring to stimulate the children's curiosity.

They will continue to add to their letter sounds and to take part in "Letters & Sounds" activities.

At home – please continue to support your child sharing at least one book EVERY DAY!

Curriculum Information

Nursery – Spring 2015 (2nd half)

Mathematics

The children will continue to develop their mathematical skills through practical activities. We will be counting, sorting and ordering objects Related to farms and farming, as well as using farm animals to begin some simple addition and subtraction.

At home – please support your child by practising basic mathematical skills DAILY!

Understanding the World

We will be thinking about where our food actually comes from (before it gets to the supermarket!!). We are hoping to get some grain for the children to have a go at grinding some flour and we will attempt to make some butter! We will also do some Planting.

At home – help your child to understand about food in its raw state before it is prettily packaged up.

Expressive Arts & Design
