

PUPIL PREMIUM OVERVIEW

Pupil Premium is additional funding from the government to help narrow the achievement gap in vulnerable groups of children.

These groups are based on:-

- The number of children who are looked after.
- The number of children receiving free school meals or who have received free school meals during the last 6 years.
- The number of children from service families.

Every school is free to decide how best to direct this funding to meet the needs of individual pupils. It is important to note, that overall the percentage of these pupils in our school is lower than national.

FINANCIAL YEAR 2014/15

Our school received £120,300 and this is how we spent the funding:-

- Additional support teaching to reduce teaching group sizes.
- Additional Learning Support Assistant
- Staff Training
- SEN Resources
- Nurture/Pastoral Support
- One to One Provision for any targeted underachieving pupils
- External Monitoring Support
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In addition Pupil Premium funding was made available for special events for those vulnerable pupils who needed it.

THIS WAS THE IMPACT BY THE END OF THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2014/2015

There was a significant improvement from the previous year. Following a rigorous and effective action plan the gap between our pupil premium children and their peers narrowed. Across the school, pupil premium children made expected or better than expected progress.

- End of KS1 (12 pupils)
100% reached or exceeded Level 2B+ in reading, writing and maths. Progress across KS1 in the above

subjects was 10 points.

- End of KS2 (15 pupils)
60% achieved Level 4 reading, writing and maths combined.

7% achieved Level 5 in all 3 subjects.

A particular success was the Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling Test: -60% = Level 4 33% = Level 5

Progress across KS2 in the above subjects was good or better.

2 levels - 80% = Reading

73% = Writing

87% = Maths

3 levels - 20% = Reading

27% = Writing

33% = Maths
