



Year 2 Home Learning Information

In addition to reading during Literacy lessons, children in Year 2 usually have two 'Guided Reading' sessions each week in which they develop and practise reading strategies and discuss books with a Teacher and Teaching Assistant. The children also choose books from an appropriately challenging selection for further daily reading at home. We check whether these books need changing at least twice a week. It is important that your child has time to read, discuss and practise unfamiliar words rather than rush through each colour band.

All studies show that children who read regularly at home succeed at school!

Most weeks we send home a piece of Maths and Phonics home learning. Please remind your child it is their responsibility to hand it in once it has been completed. Occasionally, we will give out Topic home learning as well.

Please continue to practise the spelling word banks we will send home every few weeks. It is important your child knows how to spell these words correctly.
